This is the final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), dated September 11, 2013. You are seeking system records pertaining to the locations, name and bed space count for ICE detention facilities.

To provide you with the greatest degree of access authorized by law, we have considered your request under both the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, and the Privacy Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552a. Information about an individual that is maintained in a Privacy Act system of records may be accessed by that individual¹ unless the agency has exempted the system of records from the access provisions of the Privacy Act.²

We are granting your request under the FOIA, Title 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended, and DHS' implementing regulations, 6 C.F.R. Chapter I and Part 5. After carefully reviewing the responsive documents, I determined that they are appropriate for public release. They are enclosed in their entirety; no deletions or exemptions have been claimed.
