
Re: N-600 Application for Certificate of Citizenship

Dear Mr. Robles:

Your N-600 Application for a Certificate of Citizenship was approved on June 15, 2011. You derive citizenship on June 13, 2002, when your father became a naturalized citizen of the United States. However, since you were deported from the United States, we are unable to complete the N-600 application process and provide you with a certificate of citizenship.

Upon your return to the United States, please make an appointment at the USCIS office closest to your current location. At that time, the local office will be able to assist you in obtaining your certificate of citizenship. Currently USCIS uses INFOPASS system to allow our customers to schedule appointments to speak to an Immigration officer. To schedule an INFO Pass appointment, go to [www.uscis.gov](http://www.uscis.gov) and click on "Make an Appointment." When you schedule your appointment, please remember to bring some type of photo identification and a copy of this letter.
